



REGULATIONS OF THE SWIMMING POOL AT SOL ANDALUSI COMPLEX

The Board of Directors may provide cards or authorisations for access to the swimming pool and shall establish the rules for their use. These cards or authorisations must, where appropriate, be shown if requested by the person in charge of the Residential Complex or the security personnel. In this case, personalised wristbands will be provided for greater control.

These badges will be provided to any person who lives continuously with the owner or resident. Wristbands will be issued according to the following list:

- 2 bed apartments or bigger: 6 wristbands
- 1 bed apartments: 4 wristbands
- Studios: 3 wristbands

The following rules shall be observed while on the pool grounds:

- a) Appropriate attire shall be worn at all times while in the entrance or on the pool grounds, meaning swimwear, a shirt or T-shirt and appropriate footwear. Entry into the pool will not be permitted wearing anything other than swimwear or a bikini, and only with that.
- b) No ball playing or other activities are allowed which may create a nuisance for other users except in expressly authorised areas
- c) It is forbidden to consume food inside the pool. It is also forbidden to bring in glasses or glass bottles. There is an area next to the bathing area where drinks and food may be consumed.
- d) All users are required to shower prior to entering the swimming pool. Under no circumstances shall any type of soap or detergent be used in the community showers
- e) It is not allowed to leave personal belongings when leaving the swimming pool area. In order to allow the greatest possible number of residents to enjoy the facilities, the lifeguard is authorized to remove any personal belongings if left unattended.
- f) The instructions of the safety and maintenance personnel of the swimming pool must be obeyed at all times and they are expressly authorised to enforce compliance with the rules for the use of the swimming pool and to insist that users desist in any infractions or abandon the grounds.
